**Score: 32 - 8**

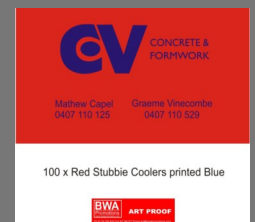

### Under 16 Division 1 V Tamborine

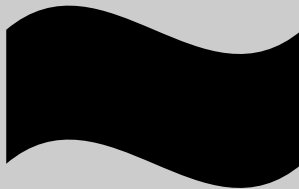
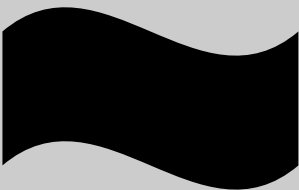
**Score: 4 - 20**
