## President's Update

Well that is the end of the season for most of the players and how disappointed are they. What is everyone going to do with all that extra time on their hands?

Its been a great year so far for the Club with an increase in registrations and overall team numbers. We have achieved to have more teams in the semi finals than any other season on record and there are eight teams now getting ready for their assault on the playoff rounds.

The first weekend of Semi Finals is being held at Runaway Bay and we will be represented on both Saturday and Sunday. The Under 12 Div 2 Red team won a playoff for fourth spot on Tuesday evening and they are up against Nerang on Sunday at 10.40am. On Saturday we have the Under 14 Div 2 side playing Currumbin at 10.40am, the Under 14 Premier team playing Helensvale at 1.00pm and the Under 15 Div 2 side playing Beaudesert at 2.10pm. All go into their games with a good chance of progressing through to the Preliminary Final in two weeks time & firstly its congratulations to you all for your efforts throughout the season and then its good luck on the weekend.

Next weekend at Burleigh we have the Under 16 Premier team playing Runaway Bay on Friday evening at 7.15pm, then on Sunday we have the Under 11 Conference 1 side playing Nerang at 8.30am, the Under 12 Div 1 team playing Nerang at 11.50am and the Under 13 Premier team playing Burleigh at 3.40pm.

We also are competing in the Kevvie Gordon Medal, which is a 100m dash to see who is the

fastest junior player in the District. Dylan Stewart from our U14 Premier side will be our entrant here and last year he ran a remarkable third against players 4 years older than himself. In the Mick Viever's Cup which is a relay we are represented by Brock Roberts from the U7's, Dorion Smith from the U9's, Trent Grove from the U11's, Lochie Oxley from the U13's, Dylan Stewart from the U14's and Mack Niamsuphap from the U16's. The lads have to run in full gear and carry a football with them so we need to be out in force not only to support our teams but to cheer our sprinters home.

Our 3 Under 10 sides also competed in the annual U10 Challenge and all performed admirably. The Under 10 Reds went through to the Grand Final only to be beaten 16 to 8 in controversial circumstances by Burleigh Silver. It was a great effort by the lads and they were a credit to the Club.

Presentation Days are around the corner with the Under 6 – Under 10 Presentation to be held on Saturday 20 August at Firth Park between 10am and 2.00pm. We will again hold the Mini Olympics so that the kids can compete against each other in their age groups as this has been an event that they have enjoyed over the past two seasons.

The Under 11 – Under 14 Presentation Day is scheduled for Sunday 11 September and the Under 15 – Under 16 Presentation Dinner is scheduled for Friday 9 September. For the first time we have

decided to hold a season debrief session with all Coaches and Managers. This will be a forum where Coaches and Managers can air their opinions, advise of any issues they or parents had during 2011 and provide us with possible solutions. It will also be an opportunity for us to advise Club Policy for different age groups for 2012 and hopefully get everybody on the same page for the off season and season 2012. If you have any ideas, issues that you would like aired or discussed please provide them to your Coach or Manager as soon as possible. The U6 – U10 Debrief is being held on Thursday 18 August so that they can all report back to the parents on Presentation Day.

Anyway that's about it for the moment, other than Coaches and Managers to bring back their jerseys and training gear over the next two Thursdays so that we can get it all stacked and stored for next season.

Well done to all the kids, mums and dads and everyone who has been involved in Season 2011 with the Redbacks. It's been a great year and we look forward to a successful finish with our semi final teams and presentation days.

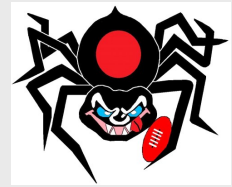

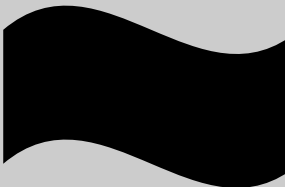
